- 1 AN ACT Relating to standardized health care transaction forms;
- 2 adding new sections to chapter 41.05 RCW; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 41.05 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The department of health, the authority, the department of social and health services, the office of the insurance commissioner,
- and the department of labor and industries must form an interagency 8
- group for coordination and consultation on standardized health care 9
- 10 transaction forms for all state purchased health care.
- (2) The interagency group must include representatives of health 11
- carriers licensed under Title 48 RCW, health professionals licensed 12
- 13 under Title 18 RCW, and employer purchasers of health care.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 41.05 RCW
- to read as follows: 15

- 16 (1) The interagency group for coordination and consultation on
- standardized health care transaction forms created under section 1 of 17
- this act must establish standardized health care transaction forms for 18

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- 1 all transactions involving state purchased health care, as defined in
- 2 RCW 41.05.011. In developing transaction forms, the interagency group
- 3 must minimize provider burden and administrative cost resulting from
- 4 varying data submission requirements.
- 5 (2) The standardized health care transaction forms must be
- 6 consistent with all federal requirements of the health insurance
- 7 portability and accountability act of 1996, and include:
- 8 (a) Claims;
- 9 (b) Enrollment;
- 10 (c) Eligibility;
- 11 (d) Payment and remittance;
- 12 (e) Premium payment;
- 13 (f) Claim status;
- 14 (g) Referral and authorization; and
- 15 (h) Coordination of benefits.
- 16 (3) The standardized health care transaction forms must be
- 17 operational and in use no later than October 1, 2002.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** If any provision of this act or its
- 19 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 20 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 21 persons or circumstances is not affected.
- 22 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 23 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 24 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 25 immediately.

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
