- 1 AN ACT Relating to syrup taxes; adding a new section to chapter
- 2 82.04 RCW; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) In computing the tax imposed under this chapter, a taxpayer may

claim a credit for all taxes imposed under RCW 82.64.020 and paid to a

- 8 wholesaler or to the department. Credits shall not exceed the amount
- 9 of tax paid by the taxpayer under this chapter during the reporting
- 10 period. Credits in excess of tax paid under this chapter in a
- 11 reporting period may be carried forward to future reporting periods for
- 12 a maximum of one year.
- 13 (2) For the purposes of this section, "taxpayer" does not include
- 14 a wholesaler with respect to tax collected by the wholesaler and paid
- 15 to the department under RCW 82.64.050.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 17 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the

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- 1 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 2 July 1, 2001.

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
