- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 66.08.026 and 1998 c 265 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- All administrative expenses of the board incurred on and after 6
- April 1, 1963 shall be appropriated and paid from the liquor revolving
- fund. These administrative expenses shall include, but not be limited 8
- 9
- The salaries and expenses of the board and its employees, the cost
- 10 of establishing, leasing, maintaining, and operating state liquor
- stores and warehouses, legal services, pilot projects, annual or other 11
- 12 audits, and other general costs of conducting the business of the
- 13 board, and the costs of supplying, installing, and maintaining
- equipment used in state liquor stores and agency liquor vendor stores 14
- 15 for the purchase of liquor by nonlicensees using debit or credit cards.
- 16 The administrative expenses shall not, however, be deemed to include
- 17 and lottery tickets purchased, the liquor
- transportation and delivery to the point of distribution, other costs 18
- pertaining to the acquisition and receipt of liquor and lottery 19

tickets, packaging and repackaging of liquor, agency commissions for agency liquor vendor stores, transaction fees associated with credit or 2 3 debit card purchases for liquor in state liquor stores and in the 4 stores of agency liquor vendors pursuant to RCW 66.16.040 and 66.16.041, sales tax, and those amounts distributed pursuant to RCW 5 66.08.180, 66.08.190, 66.08.200, 66.08.210 and 66.08.220. 6 7 commissions for agency liquor vendor stores shall be established by the 8 liquor control board after consultation with and approval by the director of the office of financial management. All expenditures and 9 payment of obligations authorized by this section are subject to the 10 allotment requirements of chapter 43.88 RCW. 11
