1 AN ACT Relating to car pooling by intermediate license holders; and  
2 amending RCW 46.20.075.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.075 and 2000 c 115 s 2 are each amended to read  
5 as follows:

6 (1) An intermediate license authorizes the holder to drive a motor  
7 vehicle under the conditions specified in this section. An applicant  
8 for an intermediate license must be at least sixteen years of age and:

9 (a) Have possessed a valid instruction permit for a period of not  
10 less than six months;

11 (b) Have passed a driver licensing examination administered by the  
12 department;

13 (c) Have passed a course of driver's education in accordance with  
14 the standards established in RCW 46.20.100;

15 (d) Present certification by his or her parent, guardian, or  
16 employer to the department stating (i) that the applicant has had at  
17 least fifty hours of driving experience, ten of which were at night,  
18 during which the driver was supervised by a person at least twenty-one  
19 years of age who has had a valid driver's license for at least three

1 years, and (ii) that the applicant has not been issued a notice of  
2 traffic infraction or cited for a traffic violation that is pending at  
3 the time of the application for the intermediate license;

4 (e) Not have been convicted of or found to have committed a traffic  
5 violation within the last six months before the application for the  
6 intermediate license; and

7 (f) Not have been adjudicated for an offense involving the use of  
8 alcohol or drugs during the period the applicant held an instruction  
9 permit.

10 (2) For the first six months after the issuance of an intermediate  
11 license or until the holder reaches eighteen years of age, whichever  
12 occurs first, the holder of the license may not operate a motor vehicle  
13 that is carrying any passengers under the age of twenty who are not  
14 members of the holder's immediate family as defined in RCW 42.17.020;  
15 except that the holder may operate a motor vehicle for car-pool  
16 purposes under subsection (8) of this section. For the remaining  
17 period of the intermediate license, the holder may not operate a motor  
18 vehicle that is carrying more than three passengers who are under the  
19 age of twenty who are not members of the holder's immediate family;  
20 except that the holder may operate a motor vehicle for car-pool  
21 purposes under subsection (8) of this section.

22 (3) The holder of an intermediate license may not operate a motor  
23 vehicle between the hours of 1 a.m. and 5 a.m. except when the holder  
24 is accompanied by a parent, guardian, or a licensed driver who is at  
25 least twenty-five years of age.

26 (4) It is a traffic infraction for the holder of an intermediate  
27 license to operate a motor vehicle in violation of the restrictions  
28 imposed under this section.

29 (5) Enforcement of this section by law enforcement officers may be  
30 accomplished only as a secondary action when a driver of a motor  
31 vehicle has been detained for a suspected violation of this title or an  
32 equivalent local ordinance or some other offense.

33 (6) An intermediate licensee may drive at any hour without  
34 restrictions on the number of passengers in the vehicle if necessary  
35 for agricultural purposes.

36 (7) An intermediate licensee may drive at any hour without  
37 restrictions on the number of passengers in the vehicle if, for the  
38 twelve-month period following the issuance of the intermediate license,  
39 he or she:

1 (a) Has not been involved in an automobile accident; and  
2 (b) Has not been convicted or found to have committed a traffic  
3 offense described in chapter 46.61 RCW or violated restrictions placed  
4 on an intermediate licensee under this section.

5 (8) An intermediate licensee may drive a car pool to and from  
6 school during normal school and extracurricular hours, but not to or  
7 from events starting after 7:00 p.m., and may carry three or fewer  
8 passengers under the age of twenty who are not members of the holder's  
9 immediate family if the car pooling would reduce traffic and parking  
10 congestion in the immediate area of the school.
