## SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 1838

- 1 AN ACT Relating to school mapping; creating a new section; and
- 2 making an appropriation.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1) The legislature finds that school 5 mapping would:
- 6 (a) Protect all students in Washington;
- 7 (b) Help schools and emergency response teams in emergencies like 8 the recent Columbine, Colorado, shootings;
- 9 (c) Help officers on the ground to know how a school is laid out in
- 10 an emergency, since some schools are so complex that when an officer
- 11 arrives at the school, the officer may be unable to determine where a
- 12 potential gunman is located; and
- (d) Be used for any potential crisis situation.
- 14 (2) As used in this section, school mapping includes:
- 15 (a) Mapping out the physical structures of all schools in case of
- 16 an emergency;
- 17 (b) Taking aerial shots from the air to understand the physical
- 18 complexity of a school;

- 1 (c) Photographing the school from the air so the officers on the 2 ground will know just how the school is laid out in case of an 3 emergency;
  - (d) Giving an officer as much information about the school layout as possible by creating a centralized data base for school layouts; and
- 6 (e) Providing for information sharing between the schools and 7 emergency response teams.
- 8 (3) The Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs and 9 the Washington association of fire chiefs shall study and determine the 10 feasibility and costs of:
  - (a) Completing a school map for all K-12 schools within the state;
  - (b) Including all school maps on a computer disk;

- 13 (c) Providing all patrol cars and fire engines with a mounted 14 computer so that the officer can use the computer disk to view pictures 15 of the layout of each school, including a blueprint of the school, an 16 aerial photo, and a photo of each school room; and
- 17 (d) Providing for maintenance of the computer disks by the fire 18 chief and the Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs.
- 19 (4) The Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs and 20 the Washington association of fire chiefs shall submit a report on the 21 study and recommendations to the legislature by January 1, 2002.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The sum of four hundred fifty thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, from the general fund to the Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs for the purposes of this act.
