- 1 AN ACT Relating to school mapping; and creating a new section.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1) The legislature finds that school 4 mapping would:
- 5 (a) Protect all students in Washington;
- 6 (b) Help schools and emergency response teams in emergencies like 7 the recent Columbine, Colorado, shootings;
- 8 (c) Help officers on the ground to know how a school is laid out in
- 9 an emergency, since some schools are so complex that when an officer
- 10 arrives at the school, the officer may be unable to determine where a
- 11 potential gunman is located; and
- 12 (d) Be used for any potential crisis situation.
- 13 (2) As used in this section, school mapping includes:
- 14 (a) Mapping out the physical structures of all schools in case of
- 15 an emergency;
- 16 (b) Taking aerial shots from the air to understand the physical
- 17 complexity of a school;

- 1 (c) Photographing the school from the air so the officers on the 2 ground will know just how the school is laid out in case of an 3 emergency;
  - (d) Giving an officer as much information about the school layout as possible by creating a centralized data base for school layouts; and
- 6 (e) Providing for information sharing between the schools and 7 emergency response teams.
- 8 (3) The Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs shall 9 study and determine the feasibility and costs of:
  - (a) Completing a school map for all K-12 schools within the state;
- 11 (b) Including all school maps on a computer disk;

- (c) Providing all patrol cars with a mounted computer so that the officer can use the computer disk to view pictures of the layout of each school, including a blueprint of the school, an aerial photo, and a photo of each school room; and
- 16 (d) Providing for maintenance of the computer disks by the 17 Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs.
- 18 (4) The Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs shall 19 submit a report on the study and recommendations to the legislature by 20 January 1, 2002.
