1 AN ACT Relating to the use of identifying information in 2 professional licenses; adding a new section to chapter 43.24 RCW; and 3 providing an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 43.24 RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 Social security numbers and drivers' license numbers may not be 8 used as part of a professional license. Professional licenses 9 containing such information that are in existence on the effective date 10 of this section shall comply with this section by the next renewal 11 date.

12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. This act takes effect January 1, 2002.
