## SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 1921

1 AN ACT Relating to greenhouse gases affecting climate change; 2 creating a new section; and providing an expiration date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. (1) A joint select committee on climate
change is established. The joint select committee shall study and
make recommendations to the legislature on the potential:

(a) Impacts of climate change in the state; and

8 (b) Effects of early action by the state, before action by the 9 federal government or other state governments, on the state's 10 competitive position with respect to other states.

11 (2) The joint select committee shall be composed of fifteen 12 members as follows:

(a) One member of the senate from each of the two major
political party caucuses in the senate, appointed by the president
of the senate;

(b) One member of the house of representatives from each of the
two major political parties in the house of representatives,
appointed by the co-speakers of the house of representatives;

(c) Two members from the environmental community, appointed by
 the president of the senate and the co-speakers of the house of
 representatives;

4 (d) Two members from the agriculture industry, appointed by the
5 president of the senate and the co-speakers of the house of
6 representatives;

7 (e) Two members from the business community, appointed by the
8 president of the senate and the co-speakers of the house of
9 representatives; and

10 (f) One member from each of the following, appointed by the president of the senate and the co-speakers of the house of 11 representatives: The timber industry, county government, city 12 13 government, irrigation districts, and municipal water purveyors. 14 (3) The members of the joint select committee shall elect co-15 chairs from among the committee members who are members of the legislature, each from a different political party. The initial 16 meeting of the joint select committee shall be convened by the 17 directive of the president of the senate and the co-speakers of 18 19 the house of representatives. Staff support for the joint select committee shall be provided by senate committee services and the 20 office of program research. Members of the committee from the house 21 of representatives and the senate shall be compensated for their 22 expenses as provided by the house of representatives and the 23 24 senate.

(4) The joint select committee shall report its interim findings to the legislature regarding the issues identified in subsection (1) of this section by December 31, 2001. The joint select committee shall report final recommendations to the legislature regarding the issues identified in subsection (1) of this section by June 30, 2002.

31 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. Section 1 of this act expires July 1, 32 2002.
