- 1 AN ACT Relating to a mandatory community service graduation
- 2 requirement; adding a new section to chapter 28A.230 RCW; and creating
- 3 a new section.

State of Washington

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that:
- 6 (1) The greatest impact on the community and with students is made
- 7 when schools arrange and require community service opportunities, 56.3%
- 8 of students in grades six through twelve did community service if it
- 9 was arranged and required, compared to 18.9% if it was only required.
- 10 (2) Thirty-two percent of all public schools, including nearly half
- 11 of all high schools, organized community service as part of their
- 12 curriculum.
- 13 (3) Eighty-three percent of public high schools nationwide had
- 14 students participating in community service activities recognized by
- 15 the schools.
- 16 (4) This legislation is taken directly from Maryland legal code.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.230
- 18 RCW to read as follows:

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Students shall complete seventy-five hours of student service that includes preparation, action, and reflection components and that, at the discretion of the local school system, may begin during the middle grades; or a locally designed program in student service that has been approved by the state superintendent of public instruction. These requirements must be completed before graduation.

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
