1 AN ACT Relating to requiring local shoreline master plan compliance
2 with the endangered species act; and amending RCW 90.58.080.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 90.58.080 and 1995 c 347 s 305 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 Local governments shall develop or amend, within twenty-four months
7 after the adoption of guidelines as provided in RCW 90.58.060, a master
8 program for regulation of uses of the shorelines of the state
9 consistent with the required elements of the guidelines adopted by the
10 department. If the area covered by a local government master plan
11 contains a species listed as threatened or endangered under 16 U.S.C.
12 Sec. 1538, the local government must either: (1) Use the sections of
13 the guidelines adopted under RCW 90.58.060 that have been approved as
14 sufficient to protect that species; or (2) obtain an approved habitat
15 conservation plan under 16 U.S.C. Sec. 1539 or an exemption under 16
16 U.S.C. Sec. 1533(d) prior to approval by the department.
