- 1 AN ACT Relating to requiring local shoreline master plan compliance
- 2 with the endangered species act; and amending RCW 90.58.080.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 90.58.080 and 1995 c 347 s 305 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 Local governments shall develop or amend, within twenty-four months
- after the adoption of quidelines as provided in RCW 90.58.060, a master
- program for regulation of uses of the shorelines of the state 8
- 9 consistent with the required elements of the quidelines adopted by the
- 10 department. If the area covered by a local government master plan
- contains a species listed as threatened or endangered under 16 U.S.C. 11
- Sec. 1538, the local government must either: (1) Use the sections of 12
- 13 the quidelines adopted under RCW 90.58.060 that have been approved as
- 14 sufficient to protect that species; or (2) obtain an approved habitat
- 15 conservation plan under 16 U.S.C. Sec. 1539 or an exemption under 16
- 16 U.S.C. Sec. 1533(d) prior to approval by the department.
