- 1 AN ACT Relating to eliminating criminal penalties for trapping the
- 2 common mouse, rat, or mole; and amending RCW 77.15.190.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.15.190 and 1999 c 258 s 9 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
 - (1) A person is guilty of unlawful trapping if the person:
- 7 (a) Sets out traps that are capable of taking wild animals, game 8 animals, or furbearing mammals and does not possess all licenses, tags,
- 9 or permits required under this title;
- 10 (b) Violates any rule of the commission or director regarding
- 11 seasons, bag or possession limits, closed areas including game
- 12 reserves, closed times, or any other rule governing the trapping of
- 13 wild animals; or
- 14 (c) Fails to identify the owner of the traps or devices by neither
- 15 (i) attaching a metal tag with the owner's department-assigned
- 16 identification number or the name and address of the trapper legibly
- 17 written in numbers or letters not less than one-eighth inch in height
- 18 nor (ii) inscribing into the metal of the trap such number or name and
- 19 address.
