AN ACT Relating to prohibiting health carriers from using social security numbers as personal identification numbers; adding a new section to chapter 48.43 RCW; and creating new sections.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that if social security numbers are accessible to the public, it will be relatively б 7 easy for someone to use another's social security number fraudulently to assume that person's identity and gain access to bank accounts, 8 credit services, billing information, driving history, and other 9 10 sources of personal information. The legislature intends to limit the collection and availability of social security numbers to protect the 11 12 public.

13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 48.43 RCW 14 to read as follows:

After January 1, 2003, no carrier may use social security numbers from individuals as a personal identification number.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. If any part of this act is found to be in 1 2 conflict with federal requirements that are a prescribed condition to 3 the allocation of federal funds to the state, the conflicting part of 4 this act is inoperative solely to the extent of the conflict and with respect to the agencies directly affected, and this finding does not 5 affect the operation of the remainder of this act in its application to б 7 the agencies concerned. Rules adopted under this act must meet federal 8 requirements that are a necessary condition to the receipt of federal 9 funds by the state.
