- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29.07.115 and 1994 c 57 s 15 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 No person, organization, or association may distribute voter
- 7 registration applications within this state that contain a return
- 8 address other than that of the office of the secretary of state or the
- 9 appropriate county auditor.
- 10 No person printing voter registration forms may include advertising
- 11 of any kind, or statements advocating or opposing candidates, ballot
- 12 measures, or political positions, as a part of the voter registration
- 13 <u>application</u>.
- 14 <u>No person distributing voter registration forms may use a postal</u>
- 15 permit to pay the postage for the individual return of voter
- 16 <u>registration forms</u>.
- 17 <u>A person or organization collecting voter registration applications</u>
- 18 has a responsibility to protect the privacy of persons whom they are
- 19 assisting with voter registration. No voter registration form, as

- 1 established by RCW 29.07.070, that has been signed by a prospective
- 2 voter, may be copied before official processing by county or state
- 3 <u>voter registration officials.</u>
- 4 A person or organization collecting voter registration application

- 6 at least once weekly.
