- 1 AN ACT Relating to studying long-term care insurance costs;
- 2 creating new sections; and making an appropriation.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The office of the insurance commissioner
- 5 shall conduct a study on the availability and affordability of
- 6 liability insurance for adult family homes, boarding homes, nursing
- 7 homes, and assisted living facilities. The study shall include a
- 8 review of self-insurance as an alternative for affected residential
- 9 care providers.
- 10 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The office of the insurance commissioner
- 11 shall conduct a study of long-term care insurance coverage for
- 12 residential care services for individuals requiring long-term care.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** There is appropriated from the insurance
- 14 commissioner's regulatory account to the office of the insurance
- 15 commissioner, on the effective date of this act, the amount of three

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- 1 hundred thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, for
- 2 the purposes of this act.

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
