- 1 AN ACT Relating to monitoring programs for the education of highly
- 2 capable students; and adding a new section to chapter 28A.185 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 28A.185
- 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 In order to ensure that school districts are meeting
- requirements of an approved program for highly capable students, the
- superintendent of public instruction shall monitor highly capable 8
- 9 programs at least once every five years. Monitoring shall begin during
- 10 the 2002-03 school year.
- 11 Any program review and monitoring under this section may be
- 12 conducted concurrently with other program reviews and monitoring
- 13 conducted by the office of the superintendent of public instruction.
- 14 In its review, the office shall monitor program components that include
- 15 but need not be limited to the process used by the district to identify
- and reach out to highly capable students with diverse talents and from 16
- 17 diverse backgrounds, and district expenditures used to enrich or expand
- opportunities for these students. 18
