AN ACT Relating to unfounded reports of child abuse or neglect by child day-care centers and family day-care providers; and amending RCW 26.44.031.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 26.44.031 and 1997 c 282 s 1 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 (1) To protect the privacy in reporting and the maintenance of reports of nonaccidental injury, neglect, death, sexual abuse, and 8 9 cruelty to children by their parents, and to safeguard against 10 arbitrary, malicious, or erroneous information or actions, the department shall not maintain information related to unfounded 11 referrals in files or reports of child abuse or neglect for longer than 12 13 six years except as provided in this section.

14 <u>(2)</u> At the end of six years from receipt of the unfounded report, 15 the information shall be purged unless an additional report has been 16 received in the intervening period.

17 (3) For child day-care centers and family day-care providers
18 licensed by the department under chapter 74.15 RCW, the information
19 shall be purged at the end of three years from receipt of the unfounded

- 1 report unless an additional report has been received in the intervening
- 2 <u>period.</u>
