1 AN ACT Relating to governmental licenses, certificates, 2 endorsements, and registrations; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The legislature finds that there is evidence 5 that some state licenses and certificates are being counterfeited. As a result, people without proper training and where required, background 6 7 checks, are obtaining employment, often with our most vulnerable citizens. Because of the ease of counterfeiting these documents, there 8 are many opportunities for fraud, theft, and abuse. Therefore, the 9 10 legislature finds that in order to ensure the authenticity of these documents, there should be an inquiry into (1) requiring that 11 governmental licenses, certificates, endorsements, and registrations be 12 13 printed on paper that is resistant to counterfeiting and (2) a means for verifying such authenticity in real-time by internet or telephone. 14
