- 1 AN ACT Relating to implementing the governor's competitiveness
- 2 council report on regulations concerning ergonomics; adding a new
- 3 section to chapter 49.17 RCW; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 49.17 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) To provide greater awareness of the causes and prevention 8 approaches to musculoskeletal disorders, the department shall:
- 9 (a) Provide musculoskeletal disorder awareness educational 10 materials to employers and employees;
- 11 (b) Work with employers and employees to develop ergonomics 12 education and training programs;
- 13 (c) Work with employers and employees to identify technical 14 approaches and best practices to assist in preventing workplace 15 injuries and illnesses; and
- 16 (d) Work with employers and employees to develop general and 17 industry specific voluntary guidelines and education materials.
- 18 (2) The department shall provide periodic information to the 19 industries deemed appropriate by the department on practices,

- 1 equipment, and products that have been identified by the department as 2 being effective in reducing musculoskeletal disorders.
- 3 (3) Rules dealing with musculoskeletal disorders, adopted on May
- 4 26, 2000, by the director, and codified as WAC 296-62-05101 through
- 5 296-62-05176, shall have no force or effect and are hereby repealed.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 7 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 8 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 9 immediately.
