- 14 of blanket primary voting to nominate candidates for partisan
- 15 offices that began with the State Legislature enacting Initiative
- 16 to the Legislature No. 2 in 1935; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Voters of the State of Washington strongly support the
- 18 continued use of the blanket primaries to nominate candidates for
- 19 partisan offices, reflecting the independent nature of voters in

- 1 Washington State and allowing more moderate nominees to be made
- 2 from the major political parties;
- NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that
- 4 Congress approve a constitutional amendment allowing states to
