## HOUSE JOINT MEMORIAL 4023

## State of Washington 57th Legislature 2002 Regular Session

1 TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE W. BUSH, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, 2 AND TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF 3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED, AND TO GOVERNOR TOM RIDGE, 5 DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY:

6 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of 7 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully 8 represent and petition as follows:

9 WHEREAS, The State of Washington's economy is dependent upon 10 numerous critical infrastructures, many of which are owned and operated 11 by the private sector; and

12 WHEREAS, These critical infrastructures are highly complex and 13 interdependent, such that disruptions by natural disaster or by 14 terrorist attack may lead to cascading and escalating effects on other 15 critical infrastructures; and

16 WHEREAS, Bonneville Power Administration, which provides the 17 backbone of our state's electrical power system, has led the nation in 18 emergency preparedness and risk assessment; and

WHEREAS, Over eighty percent of our natural gas supply is imported from Canada, and our electrical grid system is highly integrated with BC Hydro; and 1 WHEREAS, The Pacific Northwest Economic Region has launched the 2 first multistate, binational Partnership for Regional Infrastructure 3 Security, bringing over one hundred twenty public and private 4 stakeholders to address interdependency issues and work toward an 5 action plan for a "disaster resistant" region; and

6 WHEREAS, The Canadian federal Office of Critical Infrastructure 7 Protection and Emergency Preparedness has agreed to support a 8 binational exercise addressing the interdependencies between border 9 states and provinces; and

10 WHEREAS, The United States Office of Critical Infrastructure 11 Protection and the Homeland Security Department have announced their 12 interest in doing a binational regional exercise with Canada;

NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully communicate their support of such an exercise being held in the Pacific Northwest under the auspices of PNWER to develop an action plan for regional infrastructure security.

BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately transmitted to the Honorable George W. Bush, President of the United States, Governor Tom Ridge, Director of the Office of Homeland Security, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the State of Washington.
