- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 19.112 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Methyl tertiary-butyl ether may not be intentionally added to any
- 7 gasoline, motor fuel, or clean fuel produced for sale or use in the
- 8 state of Washington after December 31, 2003, and in no event may methyl
- 9 tertiary-butyl ether be knowingly mixed in gasoline above six-tenths of
- 10 one percent by volume.
