1            AN ACT Relating to the use of gasoline additives; and adding a new  
2 section to chapter 19.112 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 19.112 RCW  
5 to read as follows:

6            Methyl tertiary-butyl ether may not be intentionally added to any  
7 gasoline, motor fuel, or clean fuel produced for sale or use in the  
8 state of Washington after December 31, 2003, and in no event may methyl  
9 tertiary-butyl ether be knowingly mixed in gasoline above six-tenths of  
10 one percent by volume.
