AN ACT Relating to endangerment of children and dependent persons with a controlled substance; amending RCW 43.43.830; reenacting and amending RCW 9.94A.515; adding a new section to chapter 9A.42 RCW; prescribing penalties; and declaring an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 9A.42 RCW 7 to read as follows:

A person is guilty of the crime of endangerment with a controlled 8 9 substance if the person knowingly or intentionally permits a dependent 10 child or dependent adult to be exposed to, ingest, inhale, or have 11 contact with methamphetamine or ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, or 12 anhydrous ammonia, that are being used in the manufacture of 13 methamphetamine. Endangerment with a controlled substance is a class 14 B felony.

Sec. 2. RCW 9.94A.515 and 2001 2nd sp.s. c 12 s 361, 2001 c 300 s 4, 2001 c 217 s 12, and 2001 c 17 s 1 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitions in this section apply throughout RCW 43.43.830 through 43.43.840.

26 (1) "Applicant" means:

(a) Any prospective employee who will or may have unsupervised
access to children under sixteen years of age or developmentally
disabled persons or vulnerable adults during the course of his or her
employment or involvement with the business or organization;

(b) Any prospective volunteer who will have regularly scheduled 31 32 unsupervised access to children under sixteen years of age, 33 developmentally disabled persons, or vulnerable adults during the 34 course of his or her employment or involvement with the business or 35 organization under circumstances where such access will or may involve 36 groups of (i) five or fewer children under twelve years of age, (ii) 37 three or fewer children between twelve and sixteen years of age, (iii) developmentally disabled persons, or (iv) vulnerable adults; or 38

(c) Any prospective adoptive parent, as defined in RCW 26.33.020. 1 2 (2) "Business or organization" means a business or organization 3 licensed in this state, any agency of the state, or other governmental 4 entity, that educates, trains, treats, supervises, houses, or provides 5 recreation to developmentally disabled persons, vulnerable adults, or children under sixteen years of age, including but not limited to 6 7 public housing authorities, school districts, and educational service 8 districts.

9 (3) "Civil adjudication" means a specific court finding of sexual 10 abuse or exploitation or physical abuse in a dependency action under RCW 13.34.040 or in a domestic relations action under Title 26 RCW. In 11 the case of vulnerable adults, civil adjudication means a specific 12 court finding of abuse or financial exploitation in a protection 13 proceeding under chapter 74.34 RCW. It does not include administrative 14 proceedings. The term "civil adjudication" is further limited to court 15 16 findings that identify as the perpetrator of the abuse a named 17 individual, over the age of eighteen years, who was a party to the dependency or dissolution proceeding or was a respondent in a 18 19 protection proceeding in which the finding was made and who contested 20 the allegation of abuse or exploitation.

(4) "Conviction record" means "conviction record" information as 21 defined in RCW 10.97.030(3) relating to a crime against children or 22 other persons committed by either an adult or a juvenile. It does not 23 24 include a conviction for an offense that has been the subject of an 25 expungement, pardon, annulment, certificate of rehabilitation, or other 26 equivalent procedure based on a finding of the rehabilitation of the 27 person convicted, or a conviction that has been the subject of a pardon, annulment, or other equivalent procedure based on a finding of 28 29 It does include convictions for offenses for which the innocence. defendant received a deferred or suspended sentence, unless the record 30 has been expunged according to law. 31

(5) "Crime against children or other persons" means a conviction of 32 33 any of the following offenses: Aggravated murder; first or second 34 degree murder; first or second degree kidnaping; first, second, or 35 third degree assault; first, second, or third degree assault of a child; first, second, or third degree rape; first, second, or third 36 37 degree rape of a child; first or second degree robbery; first degree arson; first degree burglary; first or second degree manslaughter; 38 39 first or second degree extortion; indecent liberties; incest; vehicular

homicide; first degree promoting prostitution; communication with a 1 minor; unlawful imprisonment; simple assault; sexual exploitation of 2 minors; first or second degree criminal mistreatment; endangerment with 3 4 a controlled substance; child abuse or neglect as defined in RCW 26.44.020; first or second degree custodial interference; first or 5 second degree custodial sexual misconduct; malicious harassment; first, 6 7 second, or third degree child molestation; first or second degree 8 sexual misconduct with a minor; patronizing a juvenile prostitute; 9 child abandonment; promoting pornography; selling or distributing 10 erotic material to a minor; custodial assault; violation of child abuse restraining order; child buying or selling; prostitution; felony 11 indecent exposure; criminal abandonment; or any of these crimes as they 12 13 may be renamed in the future.

(6) "Crimes relating to drugs" means a conviction of a crime to
manufacture, delivery, or possession with intent to manufacture or
deliver a controlled substance.

(7) "Crimes relating to financial exploitation" means a conviction for first, second, or third degree extortion; first, second, or third degree theft; first or second degree robbery; forgery; or any of these crimes as they may be renamed in the future.

(8) "Disciplinary board final decision" means any final decision issued by a disciplining authority under chapter 18.130 RCW or the secretary of the department of health for the following businesses or professions:

- 25 (a) Chiropractic;
- 26 (b) Dentistry;
- 27 (c) Dental hygiene;
- 28 (d) Massage;
- 29 (e) Midwifery;
- 30 (f) Naturopathy;
- 31 (g) Osteopathic medicine and surgery;
- 32 (h) Physical therapy;
- 33 (i) Physicians;
- 34 (j) Practical nursing;
- 35 (k) Registered nursing; and
- 36 (1) Psychology.

37 "Disciplinary board final decision," for real estate brokers and 38 salespersons, means any final decision issued by the director of the 39 department of licensing for real estate brokers and salespersons. 1 (9) "Unsupervised" means not in the presence of:

2 (a) Another employee or volunteer from the same business or3 organization as the applicant; or

4 (b) Any relative or guardian of any of the children or 5 developmentally disabled persons or vulnerable adults to which the 6 applicant has access during the course of his or her employment or 7 involvement with the business or organization.

8 (10) "Vulnerable adult" means "vulnerable adult" as defined in 9 chapter 74.34 RCW, except that for the purposes of requesting and 10 receiving background checks pursuant to RCW 43.43.832, it shall also 11 include adults of any age who lack the functional, mental, or physical 12 ability to care for themselves.

(11) "Financial exploitation" means the illegal or improper use of a vulnerable adult or that adult's resources for another person's profit or advantage.

(12) "Agency" means any person, firm, partnership, association,
corporation, or facility which receives, provides services to, houses
or otherwise cares for vulnerable adults.

19 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. This act is necessary for the immediate 20 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 21 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect 22 immediately.
