- AN ACT Relating to the definition of border area; and amending RCW 66.08.195.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.08.195 and 1995 c 159 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 For the purposes of this chapter:
- 7 (1) "Border area" means any incorporated city or town located
- 8 within seven miles of the Washington-Canadian border or any
- 9 unincorporated area that is a point of land surrounded on three sides
- 10 by saltwater and adjacent to the Canadian border, or any area
- 11 designated by the state patrol as such due to its usage in border-
- 12 related crime.
- 13 (2) "Border area per-capita law-enforcement spending" equals total
- 14 per capita expenditures in a border area on: Law enforcement operating
- 15 costs, court costs, law enforcement-related insurance, and detention
- 16 expenses, minus funds allocated to a border area under RCW 66.08.190
- 17 and 66.08.196.
- 18 (3) "Border-crossing traffic total" means the number of vehicles,
- 19 vessels, and aircraft crossing into the United States through a United

- States customs service border crossing that enter into the border area
- 2 during a federal fiscal year, using border crossing statistics and
- 3 criteria included in guidelines adopted by the department of community,
- 4 trade, and economic development.
- 5 (4) "Border-related crime statistic" means the sum of infractions
- 6 and citations issued, and arrests of persons permanently residing
- 7 outside Washington state in a border area during a calendar year.
