- 1 AN ACT Relating to the imposition of civil penalties by the
- 2 department of health against a licensed hospital that fails to report
- 3 a required event; amending RCW 70.41.130; and prescribing penalties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.41.130 and 1991 c 3 s 335 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 The department is authorized to deny, suspend, revoke, or modify a
- 8 license or provisional license in any case in which it finds that there
- 9 has been a failure or refusal to comply with the requirements of this
- 10 chapter or the standards or rules adopted under this chapter. RCW
- 11 43.70.115 governs notice of a license denial, revocation, suspension,
- 12 or modification and provides the right to an adjudicative proceeding.
- 13 The department is authorized to assess a civil fine or civil
- 14 penalty in any case in which it finds the licensee failed to report an
- 15 event that is required by statute or rule to be reported to the
- 16 <u>department</u>. The civil fine or civil penalty shall not exceed one
- 17 thousand dollars per incident unreported. The department is authorized
- 18 to approve expenditure of the civil penalty by the licensee on
- 19 improvements that would ensure future compliance in reporting, or

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- 1 reduce future incidents. Assessment of a civil fine or civil penalty
- 2 is subject to the provisions of chapters 34.05 and 43.05 RCW and RCW
- 3 43.70.095. The department may adopt rules to implement the civil fines
- 4 or civil penalties referenced in this section.

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
