- 1 AN ACT Relating to sale, distribution, or installation of air bags;
- 2 amending RCW 46.63.020; adding new sections to chapter 46.37 RCW; and
- 3 prescribing penalties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.37 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) "Air bag" means an inflatable restraint system or portion of an 8 inflatable restraint system installed in a motor vehicle.
- 9 (2) "Previously deployed air bag" means an inflatable restraint 10 system or portion of the system that has been activated or inflated as 11 a result of a collision or other incident involving the vehicle.
- 12 (3) "Nondeployed salvage air bag" means an inflatable restraint 13 system that has not been previously activated or inflated as a result
- 14 of a collision or other incident involving the vehicle.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 46.37 RCW to read as follows:
- 17 (1) A person is guilty of a gross misdemeanor if he or she knew or 18 reasonably should have known that an air bag he or she installs or

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- 1 reinstalls in a vehicle for compensation, or distributes as an auto
- 2 part is a previously deployed air bag that is part of an inflatable
- 3 restraint system.
- 4 (2) A person found guilty under subsection (1) of this section
- 5 shall be punished by a fine of five thousand dollars or by confinement
- 6 in the county jail for one year, or both.
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 46.37 RCW
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 Whenever an air bag that is part of a previously deployed
- 10 inflatable restraint system is replaced by either a new air bag that is
- 11 part of an inflatable restraint system or a nondeployed salvage air bag
- 12 that is part of an inflatable restraint system, the air bag must
- 13 conform to the original equipment manufacturer requirements and the
- 14 installer must verify that the self-diagnostic system for the
- 15 inflatable restraint system indicates that the entire inflatable
- 16 restraint system is operating properly.
- 17 **Sec. 4.** RCW 46.63.020 and 2001 c 325 s 4 are each amended to read
- 18 as follows:
- 19 Failure to perform any act required or the performance of any act
- 20 prohibited by this title or an equivalent administrative regulation or
- 21 local law, ordinance, regulation, or resolution relating to traffic
- 22 including parking, standing, stopping, and pedestrian offenses, is
- 23 designated as a traffic infraction and may not be classified as a
- 24 criminal offense, except for an offense contained in the following
