- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 48.01
- 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 A person engaged in the business of making contracts of
- 7 insurance shall not screen an individual's DNA. For purposes of
- 8 this section, "screen" means obtaining a person's DNA and
- 9 identifying the sequence of chemical base pairs or interpreting
- 10 data from DNA analysis. This section must not be interpreted to
- 11 deny payment of claims, and limited DNA information, not the
- 12 entire DNA code or sequence, may be communicated to an insurer for
- 13 purposes of documenting the obligation to pay the claim.

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
