1 AN ACT Relating to encouraging senior citizens to volunteer in 2 schools; adding a new section to chapter 28A.320 RCW; and creating a 3 new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that senior citizens have a wealth of experience and knowledge that can be of value to the б 7 children of Washington state. The legislature further finds that senior citizens are bright, enthusiastic, and passionate citizens who 8 9 care deeply about the future of Washington's citizenry. To encourage 10 the exchange of knowledge and experience between senior citizens and Washington children, senior citizens should be notified regarding 11 12 current opportunities available to them to volunteer in Washington 13 schools.

14NEW SECTION.Sec. 2.A new section is added to chapter 28A.32015RCW to read as follows:

School districts must provide notice to the community, specifically targeted to senior citizens, providing information on volunteer opportunities available at schools located within the district. For
