- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the occurrences
- 6 of identity theft are increasing. The legislature also finds that
- 7 widespread use of the federally issued social security numbers has made
- 8 identity theft more likely to occur.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (1) Institutions of higher education shall not use the social
- 12 security number of any student, staff, or faculty for identification
- 13 except for the purposes of employment, financial aid, research,
- 14 assessment, accountability, transcripts, or as otherwise required by
- 15 state or federal law.
- 16 (2) Each institution of higher education shall develop a system of
- 17 personal identifiers for students to be used for grading and other

- 1 administrative purposes. The personal identifiers may not be social
- 2 security numbers.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The institutions of higher education, in
- 4 conjunction with the higher education coordinating board and the state
- 5 board for community and technical colleges, shall submit a report to
- 6 the legislature by December 1, 2001, outlining the institution's
- 7 personal identifier system.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** Each institution of higher education shall
- 9 use its own existing budgetary funds to develop the system for personal
- 10 identifiers. No new state funds shall be allocated for this purpose.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** Section 2 of this act takes effect July 1,
- 12 2002.
