1 AN ACT Relating to restitution to the estate of crime victims; 2 amending RCW 7.68.290; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The intent of this act is to confirm the holding in *State v. Edelman*, 97 Wn. App. 161 (1999), that restitution under RCW 9.94A.142 must be paid to the estate of the victim after the victim is deceased.

8 **Sec. 2.** RCW 7.68.290 and 1997 c 358 s 3 are each amended to read 9 as follows:

If a defendant has paid restitution pursuant to court order under 10 RCW 9.92.060, 9.94A.140, 9.94A.142, 9.95.210, or 9A.20.030 and the 11 12 victim entitled to restitution cannot be found or has died, any unpaid 13 restitution shall be paid to the victim's estate or, if the victim has 14 died without being survived by any heirs, the clerk of the court shall deposit with the county treasurer the amount of restitution unable to 15 be paid to the victim. The county treasurer shall monthly transmit the 16 money to the state treasurer for deposit as provided in RCW 43.08.250. 17
