- 9 with salmonid species listed as threatened or endangered under the
- 10 federal endangered species act (16 U.S.C. Sec. 1531 et seq.) by the
- 11 national marine fisheries service must follow "path B" of the
- 12 quidelines.
- 13 Cities and counties that are in an evolutionarily significant unit
- 14 with salmonid species listed as threatened or endangered under the
- 15 federal endangered species act (16 U.S.C. Sec. 1531 et seq.) by the
- 16 national marine fisheries service must update their shoreline master
- 17 plans within two years of the date of adoption of the guidelines.
