- 8 In any legal action brought by a federally recognized Indian tribe
- 9 against the state of Washington seeking remedies set forth in the
- 10 federal Indian gaming regulatory act of 1988, 25 U.S.C. Sec. 2701 et
- 11 seq., or seeking the enforcement of the terms of a tribal/state compact
- 12 adopted under the federal Indian gaming regulatory act of 1988, 25
- 13 U.S.C. Sec. 2701 et seq. for, the state hereby consents to the
- 14 jurisdiction of the United States district court for the eastern or
- 15 western district of Washington or the state court in which the action
- 16 was commenced, conditioned upon a similar limited waiver of sovereign
- 17 immunity by the Indian tribe bringing such action. This limited waiver

- 1 of sovereign immunity shall not extend to any actions other than those
- 2 expressly set forth in this section.
