1 AN ACT Relating to the merchandising of beer and wine by employees
2 between the ages of eighteen and twenty-one on or about a licensee's
3 premises; and amending RCW 66.44.318.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.44.318 and 1995 c 100 s 2 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 Licensees holding nonretail class liquor licenses are permitted to
8 allow their employees between (~~{the}~~) the ages of eighteen and
9 twenty-one to stock, merchandise, and handle beer or wine on or about
10 the nonretail premises if there is an adult twenty-one years of age or
11 older on duty supervising such activities on the premises, and
12 licensees holding grocery store or beer and/or wine specialty shop
13 licenses exclusively are permitted to allow employees of the nonretail
14 class liquor licensee between the ages of eighteen and twenty-one to
15 stock merchandise or handle beer or wine on the retail licensee's
16 premises as long as there is an adult twenty-one years of age or older,
17 employed by the retail licensee, on duty supervising the activities on

1 the licensee's premises, however, nothing shall be construed to permit
2 a nonretail licensee's employee, between the ages of eighteen and
3 twenty-one, to handle, transport, or otherwise possess beer or wine
4 beyond the premises of the retail licensee.
