- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The senate committee on labor, commerce, and
- 5 financial institutions and the house committee on commerce and labor
 - shall cause an interim joint study to be performed regarding the
- 7 possibility that below-cost sales of petroleum may have an
- 8 anticompetitive effect. The interim study shall examine petroleum
- 9 marketing practices and evaluate whether and to what extent below-cost
- 10 sales may constitute deceptive advertising, unfair competition, or
- 11 other anticompetitive effects. The study shall also research whether
- 12 such below-cost sales promote bankruptcies, unemployment, and other
- 13 economic dislocation in the areas in which they occur.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The joint interim study shall report its
- 15 findings to the committees set forth in section 1 of this act on or
- 16 before December 1, 2001.
