- 9 among specialists, caregivers, and family. Appropriate service
- 10 delivery necessitates communication of relevant information. Barriers
- 11 to appropriate communication must be eliminated.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 13.34 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 In order to facilitate communication of information needed to serve
- 15 the best interest of any child who is the subject of a dependency case
- 16 filed under this chapter, the department of social and health services
- 17 shall, consistent with state and federal law governing the release of
- 18 confidential information, establish guidelines, and shall use those
