- 1 AN ACT Relating to special license plates for fairs; amending RCW
- 2 46.16.313; and adding a new section to chapter 46.16 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- In cooperation with the Washington state patrol and the department,
- 7 the fairs commission established under RCW 15.76.170 shall create and
- 8 design, and the department shall issue, a special fair license plate
- 9 displaying a symbol representing the categories of fairs defined in RCW
- 10 15.76.120. The special fair license plate may be used in lieu of
- 11 regular or personalized license plates for motor vehicles required to
- 12 display two motor vehicle license plates, excluding vehicles registered
- 13 under chapter 46.87 RCW, upon terms and conditions established by the
- 14 department.
- 15 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.16.313 and 1997 c 291 s 8 are each amended to read
- 16 as follows:
- 17 (1) The department may establish a fee for each type of special
- 18 license plates issued under RCW 46.16.301(1) (a), (b), or (c), as

existing before amendment by section 5, chapter 291, Laws of 1997, in 1 an amount calculated to offset the cost of production of the special 2 license plates and the administration of this program. Until December 3 4 31, 1997, the fee shall not exceed thirty-five dollars, but effective 5 with vehicle registrations due or to become due on January 1, 1998, the department may adjust the fee to no more than forty dollars. This fee 6 7 is in addition to all other fees required to register and license the 8 vehicle for which the plates have been requested. All such additional 9 special license plate fees collected by the department shall be 10 deposited in the state treasury and credited to the motor vehicle fund.

- (2) Until December 31, 1997, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application, registration, and renewal registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a collegiate license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890.
- 22 (3) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on January 1, 1998, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 23 24 upon application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a 25 collegiate license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. 26 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and 27 collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be 28 29 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 30 identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the 31 funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890. 32
- (4) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 1, 1999, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a collegiate license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the

state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890.

- 4 (5) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a 5 special baseball stadium license plate shall pay an initial fee of 6 7 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed 8 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 9 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining 10 proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be distributed to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments 11 on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as 12 13 defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 14 15 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds 16 to the state general fund.
- (6) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 17 1, 1999, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 18 19 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. 20 department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee 21 collected under this subsection for administration and collection 22 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be distributed 23 24 to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest 25 payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary 26 preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 27 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds 28 29 to the state general fund.
- 30 (7) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on January 1, 2002, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 31 upon application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a 32 special fair license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. 33 34 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and 35 collection of expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be 36 37 deposited in the state treasury and credited to the fair fund created 38 under RCW 15.76.115.

(8) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 1 1, 2003, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 2 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special fair 3 4 license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under 5 this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by 6 it. The remaining proceeds shall be deposited in the state treasury 7 8 and credited to the fair fund created under RCW 15.76.115.
