- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.94.654 and 1993 c 353 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) Whenever an air pollution control authority, or the department
- 7 of ecology for areas outside the jurisdictional boundaries of an
- 8 activated air pollution control authority, shall find that any fire

- 9 protection agency, county, or conservation district is capable of
- 10 effectively administering the issuance and enforcement of permits for
- 11 any or all of the kinds of burning identified in RCW 70.94.650 and
- 12 desirous of doing so, the authority or the department of ecology, as
- 13 appropriate, may delegate powers necessary for the issuance or
- 14 enforcement, or both, of permits for any or all of the kinds of burning
- 15 to the fire protection agency, county, or conservation district. Such
- 16 delegation may be withdrawn by the authority or the department of
- 17 ecology upon finding that the fire protection agency, county, or
- 18 conservation district is not effectively administering the permit
- 19 program.

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1 (2) The board of directors, individual board members, and duly
2 authorized employees of a conservation district who make decisions
3 regarding the issuance and enforcement of permits for burning under RCW
4 70.94.650 are not liable for decisions and actions made in good faith
5 and in compliance with this chapter.

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
