1 AN ACT Relating to the Puget Sound crab pot buoy tag program; and  
2 adding new sections to chapter 77.70 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 77.70 RCW  
5 to read as follows:

6 In order to administer a Puget Sound crab pot limit program, the  
7 department may charge a fee to crab industry licensees to reimburse the  
8 department for the production of crab pot buoy tags and the  
9 administration of a Puget Sound crab pot buoy tag program.

10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 77.70 RCW  
11 to read as follows:

12 The Puget Sound crab pot buoy tag account is created in the custody  
13 of the state treasurer. All revenues from fees from section 1 of this  
14 act must be deposited into the account. Expenditures from this account  
15 may be used for the production of crab pot buoy tags and the  
16 administration of a Puget Sound crab pot buoy tag program. Only the  
17 director or the director's designee may authorize expenditures from the

1 account. The account is subject to allotment procedures under chapter  
2 43.88 RCW but no appropriation is required for expenditures.
