- 1 AN ACT Relating to the recovery of taxpayer litigation expenses;
- 2 and adding a new section to chapter 84.08 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 84.08 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) In a proceeding before a superior court involving property
- 7 taxes, the judge may allow reasonable attorneys' fees and other
- 8 reasonable expenses, as determined by the court, incurred by the
- 9 taxpayer during the current proceeding and all prior proceedings before
- 10 the board of tax appeals, department of revenue, or county board of
- 11 equalization for the matter in dispute. These attorneys' fees and
- 12 reasonable expenses are in addition to costs or disbursements allowed
- 13 prior to the effective date of this act.
- 14 (2) Fees and expenses allowed under this section for proceedings
- 15 before the county board of equalization will be paid by checks drawn
- 16 upon the appropriate fund by the county treasurer.
- 17 (3) For the purposes of this section, "reasonable expenses"
- 18 includes, but is not limited to, expert witness fees paid by the

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- 1 taxpayer in preparing for and conducting all proceedings related to the
- 2 matter in the dispute.

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
