- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The superintendent of public instruction,
 - the state board of education, the academic achievement and
- 7 accountability commission, the professional educator standards board,
- 8 and the work force training and education coordinating board shall
- 9 evaluate the current governance structure of the K-12 public school
- 10 system in Washington state and report to the legislature with
- 11 recommendations regarding how the governance structure could be
- 12 improved. The purpose of the evaluation is to determine how well the
- 13 current governance structure functions and how it might be changed to
- 14 better serve the students and citizens of the state in the twenty-first
- 15 century. In reviewing options for changes to the governance structure,
- 16 the group shall develop multiple alternatives to the existing
- 17 governance structure. The evaluation shall be coordinated by a
- 18 facilitator of a national educational organization, if available. The
- 19 recommendations shall be presented to the education and fiscal
