- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 47.12 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- The department may enter into exchange agreements with local,
- 7 state, or federal agencies, or private nonprofit groups incorporated in
- 8 this state that are organized for environmental conservation purposes,
- 9 to convey properties under the jurisdiction of the department that
- 10 serve as environmental mitigation sites, as full or part consideration
- 11 for the grantee assuming all future maintenance and operation
- 12 obligations and costs required to maintain and operate the
- 13 environmental mitigation site in perpetuity. The conveyances must be
- 14 by quitclaim deed executed by the secretary of transportation, and must
- 15 expressly restrict the use of the property to a mitigation site
- 16 consistent with preservation of the functions and values of the site,
- 17 and must provide for the automatic reversion to the department if the
- 18 property is not used as a mitigation site or is not maintained in a
