- 1 AN ACT Relating to sex offender community notification in languages
- 2 other than English; adding a new section to chapter 4.24 RCW; and
- 3 providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 4.24 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) In order to provide the broadest possible public safety
- 8 protection, in geographic areas where there are significant populations
- 9 for whom English is not the primary language, the sheriff shall produce
- 10 level III community notification flyers in the five most common primary
- 11 languages of local resident populations.
- 12 (2) As used in this section "primary language" includes but is not
- 13 limited to Spanish, Russian, Vietnamese, Cambodian, Laotian, and
- 14 Chinese.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act takes effect July 1, 2003.
