- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29.07.115 and 1994 c 57 s 15 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 <u>No person, organization, or association may distribute voter</u>
- 7 registration applications within this state that contain a return
- 8 address other than that of the office of the secretary of state or the
- 9 appropriate county auditor.
- 10 No person printing voter registration forms may include advertising
- 11 of any kind, or statements advocating or opposing candidates, ballot
- 12 measures, or political positions, as a part of the voter registration
- 13 <u>application</u>.
- No person distributing voter registration forms may use a postal
- 15 permit or meter to pay the postage for the individual return of voter
- 16 <u>registration forms.</u>
- 17 <u>A person or organization collecting voter registration applications</u>
- 18 has a responsibility to protect the privacy of persons whom they are
- 19 assisting with voter registration. No voter registration form, as

- established by RCW 29.07.070, that has been signed by a prospective voter, may be copied, nor may the information contained in it be recorded before official processing by county or state voter registration officials.
- A person or organization collecting voter registration application forms must transmit the forms to the secretary of state or a designee at least once weekly.
