1 AN ACT Relating to standards for custom-built vehicles; amending 2 RCW 46.37.518; and adding a new section to chapter 46.04 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.04 RCW 5 to read as follows:

6 "Custom-built vehicle" means a passenger car or light truck that is 7 custom-designed and fabricated by the owner for his or her own use, and 8 does not include any major body parts from a manufactured vehicle or 9 produced for a manufactured vehicle. For titling and registration 10 purposes, a custom-built vehicle will be considered a homemade vehicle.

Sec. 2. RCW 46.37.518 and 1996 c 225 s 12 are each amended to read as follows:

Notwithstanding the requirements of this chapter, hoods and bumpers are optional equipment on street rods ((and)), kit vehicles, and <u>custom-built vehicles</u>. Street rods ((and)), kit vehicles, and custom1 <u>built vehicles</u> must comply with fender requirements under RCW
2 46.37.500(2) and the windshield requirement of RCW 46.37.410(1).
