 - (1) Temporary services agencies shall:
- 7 (a) For each new job assignment offered to an employee, give that
- 8 employee complete and accurate information concerning any health or
- 9 safety hazards they may face; and
- 10 (b) Provide, or require that the third party client provide,
- 11 without charge, safety training appropriate to the job assignment and
- 12 whatever safety equipment is required at or on the job assignment.
- 13 (2) Employees of temporary services agencies have a right to refuse
- 14 a job assignment, without reprisal, or discrimination if:
- 15 (a) The job will expose them to dangerous conditions or hazardous
- 16 materials; or

- 17 (b) They are inadequately trained or prepared for the job.
