- AN ACT Relating to financial disclosure by ballot measure sponsors;
- 2 and amending RCW 42.17.240.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 42.17.240 and 1995 c 397 s 8 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) Every elected official and every executive state officer shall 7 after January 1st and before April 15th of each year file with the 8 commission a statement of financial affairs for the preceding calendar 9 year. However, any local elected official whose term of office expires 10 immediately after December 31st shall file the statement required to be 11 filed by this section for the year that ended on that December 31st.
- 12 (2) Every candidate shall within two weeks of becoming a candidate 13 file with the commission a statement of financial affairs for the 14 preceding twelve months.
- 15 (3) Every person filing a proposed initiative or referendum measure 16 with the secretary of state shall within two weeks of filing the 17 necessary signature petitions under RCW 29.79.020 file with the 18 commission a statement of financial affairs for the preceding twelve

19 months.

- 1 (4) Every person appointed to a vacancy in an elective office or 2 executive state officer position shall within two weeks of being so 3 appointed file with the commission a statement of financial affairs for 4 the preceding twelve months.
- (((4))) (5) A statement of a candidate or appointee filed during 6 the period from January 1st to April 15th shall cover the period from 7 January 1st of the preceding calendar year to the time of candidacy or 8 appointment if the filing of the statement would relieve the individual 9 of a prior obligation to file a statement covering the entire preceding 10 calendar year.
- 11 (((5))) (6) No individual may be required to file more than once in 12 any calendar year.
- 13 (((6))) (7) Each statement of financial affairs filed under this 14 section shall be sworn as to its truth and accuracy.
- $((\frac{7}{1}))$  (8) Every elected official and every executive state officer shall file with their statement of financial affairs a statement certifying that they have read and are familiar with RCW 42.17.130 or 42.52.180, whichever is applicable.
- 19  $((\frac{(8)}{)})$  (9) For the purposes of this section, the term "executive 20 state officer" includes those listed in RCW 42.17.2401.
- $((\frac{(9)}{(9)}))$  (10) This section does not apply to incumbents or 22 candidates for a federal office or the office of precinct committee 23 officer.
