- 6 Irrigation districts that have designated their own treasurers as
- 7 provided in RCW 87.03.440 may accept credit cards, charge cards, debit
- 8 cards, smart cards, stored value cards, federal wire, and automatic
- 9 clearinghouse system transactions, or other electronic communication,
- 10 for any payment of any kind including, but not limited to, assessments,
