- 1 AN ACT Relating to eliminating Washington estate taxes on estates
- 2 with no federal tax liability; adding a new section to chapter 83.100
- 3 RCW; creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 83.100 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, no tax is
- 8 due under this chapter, and no return need be filed under this chapter,
- 9 if no federal tax is due under section 2001 of the United States
- 10 Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended or renumbered as of January
- 11 1, 2002.
- 12 (2) If a federal tax is due under section 2001 of the United States
- 13 Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended or renumbered as of January
- 14 1, 2002, the tax imposed under this chapter shall be calculated based
- 15 on the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended or
- 16 renumbered as of January 1, 2001.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act applies to decedents dying on or
- 18 after January 1, 2002.

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- 1 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act is necessary for the immediate
- 2 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 3 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect

4 immediately.

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
