- 1 TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE W. BUSH, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES,
- 2 AND TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
- 3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED, AND TO THE UNITED STATES FISH AND
- 5 WILDLIFE SERVICE:
- 6 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
- 7 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
- 8 represent and petition as follows:
- 9 WHEREAS, The Leavenworth National Fish Hatchery located on the
- 10 Icicle River, a tributary of the Wenatchee River, and operated by the
- 11 United States Fish and Wildlife Service, performs the admirable
- 12 function of producing spring chinook salmon, providing benefits to the
- 13 entire Columbia River region; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The Icicle River is a watershed that is home to three fish
- 15 species, chinook salmon, steelhead trout, and bull trout, that are
- 16 currently listed as threatened or endangered under the federal
- 17 endangered species act; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Watershed restoration efforts are being undertaken on a
- 19 large scale by the State of Washington, treaty Indian tribes, public
- 20 utility districts, county, local, and city governments, and local

- $1\,$  volunteer groups, to assist the recovery of Icicle River and Wenatchee
- 2 River salmon and trout; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Leavenworth National Fish Hatchery currently utilizes
- 4 a water withdrawal design that does not provide proper protection for
- 5 salmon and trout, some of which are naturally spawned endangered
- 6 steelhead trout, endangered spring run chinook salmon, or threatened
- 7 bull trout; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Operation of the Leavenworth National Fish Hatchery could
- 9 be modified with construction of fish passage devices that would result
- 10 in no jeopardy to listed salmon and trout;
- NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the United
- 12 States Fish and Wildlife Service will make the proper modifications, in
- 13 a timely manner, to the water withdrawal structure at the Leavenworth
- 14 National Fish Hatchery so that its operation will be consistent with
- 15 the federal endangered species act.
- 16 BE IT RESOLVED, That the United States Fish and Wildlife Service
- 17 apply for sufficient funding to construct the fish passage
- 18 modifications necessary at the Leavenworth National Fish Hatchery, and
- 19 that Congress shall see fit to appropriate the necessary funds;
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
- 21 transmitted to the Honorable George W. Bush, President of the United
- 22 States, the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, the President of
- 23 the United States Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives,
- 24 and each member of Congress from the State of Washington.
